Q. Does Baptism remit original sin only?

A. It also remits all the actual sins committed before its reception.

*Q. What is actual sin?

A. That which we commit by our own free will.

Q. How are actual sins, committed after Baptism, forgiven?

A. By the sacrament of Penance.

*Q. Are all actual sins the same?

A. No; some kill the soul by depriving it of sanctifying grace, and are called mortal sins; others merely weaken, but do not destroy sanctifying grace; and are called venial sins.

Q. How many mortal sins are necessary to deserve hell?

A. One only.

§. 2.

Q. How many capital sins are there?

A. There are seven, Pride, Avarice, Luxury, Envy, Gluttony, Anger and Sloth.

Q. Why are they called capital?

A. Because they are the source of all other sins.
