

9. The annual General Committee appointed shall consist of the Commanding Officer, and Officers, Treasurer, and three other elected members for transacting the general business of the Corps, of whom five shall be a quorum, when the signature of the presiding officer shall be an authority to the Treasurer to pay any account, and if the funds of the Corps shall at any time be insufficient to meet expenses, the Committee shall then have authority to assess all the members in a sum not exceeding "one dollar."

10. There shall be a Judicial Committee annually appointed to consist of nine members: two commissioned officers, appointed by the Commanding Officer from time to time, three non-commissioned officers, and four other members, who shall take cognizance of all charges which may be preferred against any member of the Corps, through the commanding officer.

11. The Commanding Officer, or in his absence the commissioned officer next in seniority, shall preside at all general meetings, and meetings of the General Committee, and on all committees the Adjutant, or any person appointed by him, shall act as Secretary, and no general meeting, or meeting of committees, shall be legal unless at least one commissioned officer be present.

12. All charges against any member for breach of the regulations shall be made in writing to the commanding officer.

13. The fine for absence from drill without leave shall be one shilling and three pence, and
