

1419. Every game-keeper shall, at the end of each of the months of Marche, June, September and December, in each year, forward to the Department of Lands, Forests and Fisheries, a report of his proceedings during the previous quarter and of the infringements of the game laws which have come to his knowledge during the same period. 47 V., c. 25, s. 23.

Returns to be sent to Department of Lands &c., by game-keepers.

1420. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, in his discretion, prohibit the hunting or killing of any bird or fur-bearing animal, for a period not exceeding five years. 47 V., c. 25, s. 24.

Lieutenant-Governor may prohibit hunting for five years.

1420a. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this section, on the recommendation of the Commissioner, make such rules and regulations, not inconsistent with this section, as may be necessary for carrying out the provisions contained therein, and may also amend or repeal existing forms and make others, which he may likewise amend or repeal. 59 V., c. 20, s. 11.
