With the balance of the market quiet, Silver Leaf was in good demand to-day on some fair-sized buying orders, that emanuted from Rochester. This city seems to be playing Silver Leaf as a prime favorite, large blocks being held there.

A Toronto capitalist yesterday took 50,000 shares of Leaf off the market and deposited it in his security box in one of the trust companies. He declares he will get 50 cents a share for Silver Leaf by Feb. 1 hext.

The renewal of the selling movement in Nipissing at New York drew forth new surmises and comments among local financiers, each thinking that he held the corpect solution of the affair.
