MAKING HIM LT.-GOVERNOR.

The ceremony will take place on the eighteenth day of this month.

Ontario, Nov. 9.—Sir Oliver Mowat will be sworn in as Lieut.-Governor of Ontario by Lord Aberdeen in Toronto on the 18th inst. He will take the oath of office in the Laurier Cabinet on the 17th inst., and will leave Ottawa for Toronto on that date.

HAD THE JURY'S SYMPATHY

They Found Huton Guilty of Manslaughter

YET PLEADED FOR MERCY.

Evidence Given to Show That the Son Was Brutal to His Father.

Consequently This Was Evidently Taken by the Jury as Provocation When They Made Their "Very, Very Strong Recommendation."

The charge of manslaughter against James Huton, charged with killing his son, John C. Huton, was proved at the Criminal Assizes, the jury bringing in a verdict of guilty, with a "very, very strong recommendation to mercy."

The Crown case against William Ryan as presented by J. K. Kerr, Q.C., in the Criminal Assizes last evening, ended in a perfect fiasco.

Justice Meredith pointed out that the drugs were shown to have been purchased by the girl herself and the Crown had failed to prove any connection between the drugs and William Ryan.
