Closed Very Strong Around Top Prices for the Day.

The Only Questionable Feature About the Bullish Situation is the Failure of Foreign Markets to Respond as Readily as Might be Expected for Latest Market News.

Saturday Evening, June 17. The wheat market is in quotations with the principal centres all showing higher prices.

Danubian shipments of wheat this week were as high as 112,000 bushels the corresponding week of last year.

Australian shipments of wheat this week were 100,000 bushels against none the corresponding week of last year.

GRAIN AND PRODUCE.

Flour—Ontario patents, in bags, \$3.70 to \$3.85; straight roller, \$3.25 to \$3.35; Hungarian patents, \$4.15 to \$4.25; Manitoba patents, \$3.75 to \$3.90, all on track at Toronto.

Wheat—Ontario, red and white, at 71c north and west; good, 67c to 68c north and west; No. 1 Manitoba hard, 82c at Toronto, and No. 1 Northern at 82c. Prices nominal.

Oats—White oats quoted at 20c west.

Rye—Quoted at 54c.

Barley—Quoted at 40c to 43c west.

Blackwheat—Firm; 48c north and 50c east.

Straw—City mills sell bran at \$14 and shorts at \$15, in car lots, l.o.b., Toronto.

Corn—Canadian, 96c west and American 91c to 92c on track here.

Peas—Sold at 65c west, in car lots.

Onion—Quoted at \$3.80 by the bag and \$3.00 by the barrel, on track at Toronto.

ST. LAWRENCE MARKET.

Receipts of farm produce were large to-day—1100 bushels of grain, 20 loads of hay and one of straw, with the usual Saturday's deliveries of butter, eggs and poultry.

Wheat steady, at 70c to 71c per ton, as follows: White 70c; red 71c; red; good, 69c.

Oats steady; 30c bushels sold at 35c to 39c. Hay steady; timothy sold at \$10 to \$11.50, and clover, mixed, at \$7 to \$8 per ton.

Butter plentiful, selling at 12c to 15c per lb. for the bulk, with a few choice dairy lots at 16c to 17c, to special customers. These latter prices were not often paid.

Eggs were mostly at 17c per dozen, with some few choice new-laid lots at 17c. Potatoes unchanged. Chickens sold at 50c to 60c per pair, and ducks at 70c to 90c per pair.

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THE NEW YORK BANK STATEMENT WAS UNFAVORABLE

But Had No Effect on the Stock Market, Which Was Irregular, But Closed Steadily—Local Stocks Are Very Quiet—Further Decline in Golden Star.

Saturday Evening, June 17. The New York bank statement, issued at noon to-day, was unfavorable. The cash reserve was \$20,018,475, as against \$20,272,800 a year ago, and \$48,210,705 two years ago.

The statement in detail is as follows: Loans, \$177,310,200 Inc. \$15,902,000; Deposits, \$907,710,000 Dec. 7,005,800; Specie, \$1,157,900 Dec. 7,005,800; Legal tenders, \$6,787,800 Inc. 170,500; Circulation, \$3,422,000 Dec. 2,427,000.

The exports of gold and silver from New York port to all countries for this week aggregate \$789,814 silver bars and coin and \$2,655,900 gold.

The Standard Oil Company has increased its capital stock from \$10,000,000 to \$10,000,000. Of the latter amount, \$10,000,000 is to be preferred stock, paying 1 1/2 per cent. quarterly dividends.

The business failure in Canada this week, according to R. G. Dun & Co., were 10, as against 17 last week and 16 the corresponding week of last year. In Ontario, as against 7 last week, and 4 in Quebec, as against 2 last week.

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
