REST AND HEALTH.

Ontario is blessed with several great lakes and river areas which will always be utilized as summer playgrounds. Toronto being a centre from which radiates a large number of lines, all of these are accessible. But Muskoka is easily the most popular region, and where most Torontonians plan each season comparatively inexpensive vacations in congenial and healthful surroundings. Time was when Muskoka was intended to cover only a limited section around Lake Muskoka. Now, however, it describes a general territory embracing everything from Lake Simcoe to Parry Sound in a wide sweep.

Between these two groups of lakes lies Sparrow Lake, which, with the Severn River, is visited each season by a constantly growing list of Toronto people, who find in the different hotels and boarding houses rest and enjoyment exactly suited to their requirements. Where Sparrow Lake is concerned it is advisable to make application early for rooms for vacation purposes.

The lake and district is served by Canadian National Railways. Sparrow Lake Station being the chief distributing point. It is located about 94 miles from Toronto, on the main line to Vancouver, and its altitude is 712 feet above sea level, or 460 feet higher than the Union Station at Toronto.

There is available at the ticket offices of Canadian National Railways full information regarding the hotels, boarding houses and other facilities and rates. This information is furnished free to all inquirers, and provides an excellent means of ascertaining the facilities of this summer resort.

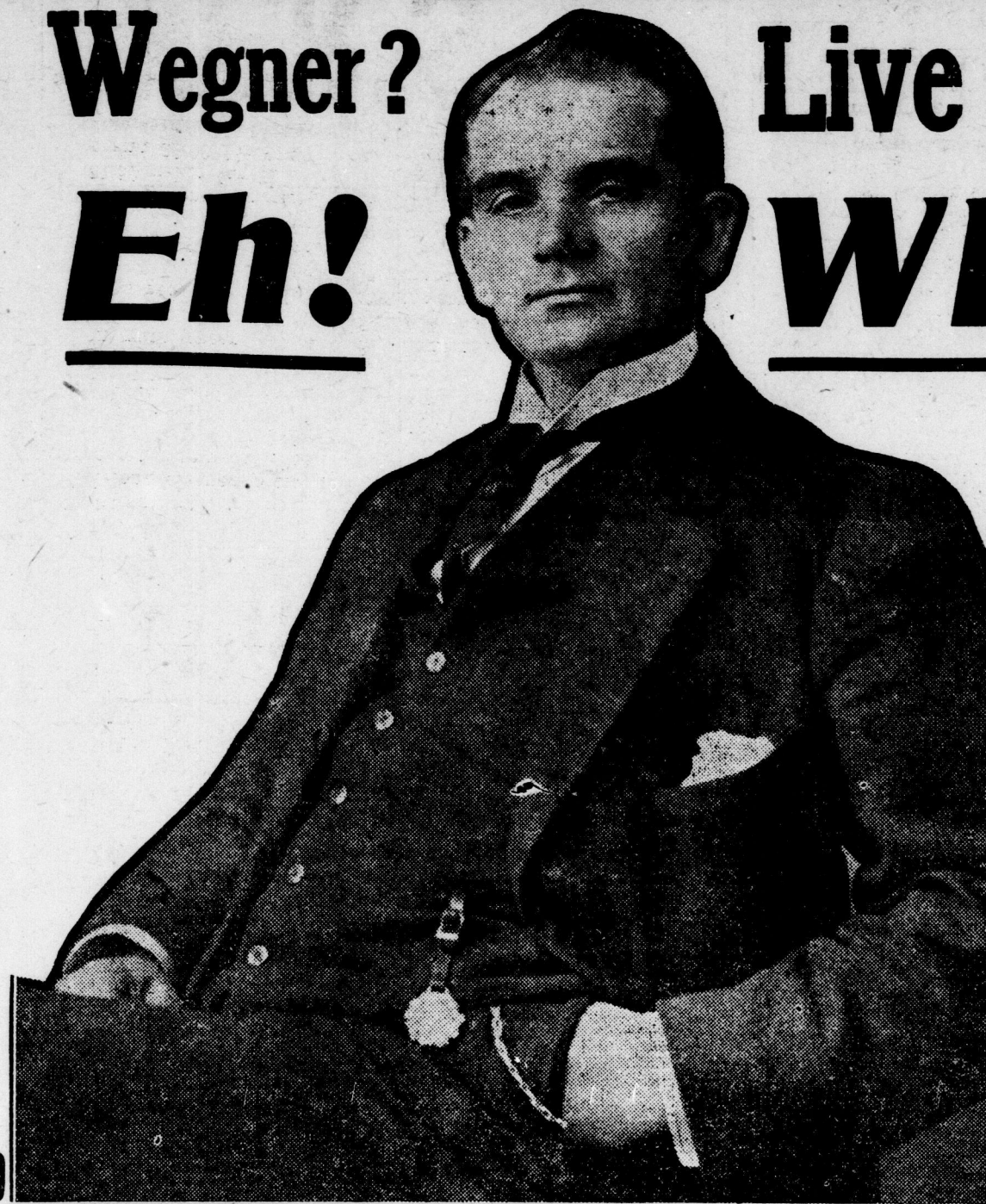
