RECENT DEATHS

Fannie Meritt Stewart.
The death occurred yesterday at her late residence, 174 Sydney street, of Fannie Meritt Stewart, 118 years of age. She was survived by one sister, Mrs. Julian H. Fairweather, of St. Francis, and one brother, Edwin N. Stewart, of this city. She is survived by two nieces and nine nephews. The funeral will be held on Friday afternoon at 2.30 o'clock from St. James' church.

J. Albert Hayden.
Woodstock, N. B., July 7—(Special)—J. Albert Hayden, who was stricken with sudden illness Monday, passed away this evening at 7.50 o'clock. The townspeople knew that he was critically ill, still the announcement of his death created universal expressions of sorrow and regret. It removed from the community a man who stood prominent in the business life and development of the town and also was keenly interested in the welfare of the town and its people and was highly esteemed and respected. He was also a devoted husband and father. At the death of his father, Mr. Hayden became the large lumber business which he had helped to build up and he was a large factor in the Woodstock Electric Light and Power Company and president of the organization. He was also president of the Northampton Brick Company. In the past three years his big lumber interests were conducted by his sons, but he was still at the wheel on all matters of importance with his able counsel and advice. He was also a regular attendant. The home life of Mr. Hayden was one of the admirable characteristics of the man. He was devoted to his wife and children and to their happiness and comfort. He was a public-spirited citizen, and all who knew him respected him for his fine business principles. To the bereaved family is extended the deepest sympathy of the whole community. Besides his wife, he leaves three daughters and seven sons. The funeral will be held on Friday.

Prof. John Bishop Tingle.
Ottawa, Aug. 7—Professor John Bishop Tingle, one of the most widely known Canadian educationalists, died yesterday morning at the residence of his brother, Dr. Alfred Tingle, 315 Frank street, at the age of fifty-one years. For some time Professor Tingle was assistant in charge of organizing chemistry at Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, and assistant editor of the American Chemical Journal, Aberdeen, Scotland, and was then appointed professor of chemistry and mineralogy at McMaster University. In 1907-08 he was president of the American Chemical Society.

Mrs. George Small of Moncton passed away suddenly yesterday from heart trouble. She was seventy-four years of age and is survived by two daughters and one son.

D. M. Elliott of Alma passed away Sunday morning from heart trouble. He is survived by his wife, one son and one daughter, one brother and two sisters.

CANADA VERY BUSY
MAKING MUNITIONS

More Than 200,000 Men and 5,000 Women Employed in 450 Plants

Ottawa, Aug. 7—How important a place the manufacture of shells fills in the industrial life of the dominion may be had from the fact that there are about 215,000 employees in the 450 Canadian plants engaged in the production of munitions. Approximately 5,000 are women.

The imperial munitions board had placed no fewer than 6,430 contracts with Canadian firms up to the end of last May.
