The undersigned has the honour to state that a resolution has been passed by the Burnt Church Band of Indiane in council approving of an expenditure up to \$1000 being made from their capital on the construction of a combined school and council house on their reserve in the County of Northumberland, Province of New Emunewick; and the Indian Agent has reported in favour of such expenditure being made. As the work when completed will be in the nature of a permanent improvement and properly represent capital, the undersigned begs to recommend that - under Section 139 of the Indian Act, as added thereto by Sec.11 of Chap.38. Vic.57-58 - anthority be given for the expenditure thereon of the above centioned sum from the Mulon capital at the oradit of the Burnt Church Band. which amounts to \$2760.00.
