The undersigned has the honour to state that a resolution has been passed by the Burnt Church Band of Indians in council approving of an expenditure up to \$1000 being made from their capital on the construction of a combined school and council house on their reserve in the County of Northumberland, Province of New Brunswick; and the Indian Agent has reported in favour of such expenditure being made.

As the work when completed will be in the nature of a permanent improvement and properly represent capital, the undersigned begs to recommend that - under Section 139 of the Indian Act, as added thereto by Sec. 11 of Chap. 32, Vic. 57-58 - authority be given for the expenditure thereon of the above mentioned sum from the capital at the credit of the Burnt Church Band, which amounts to \$2750.00.
