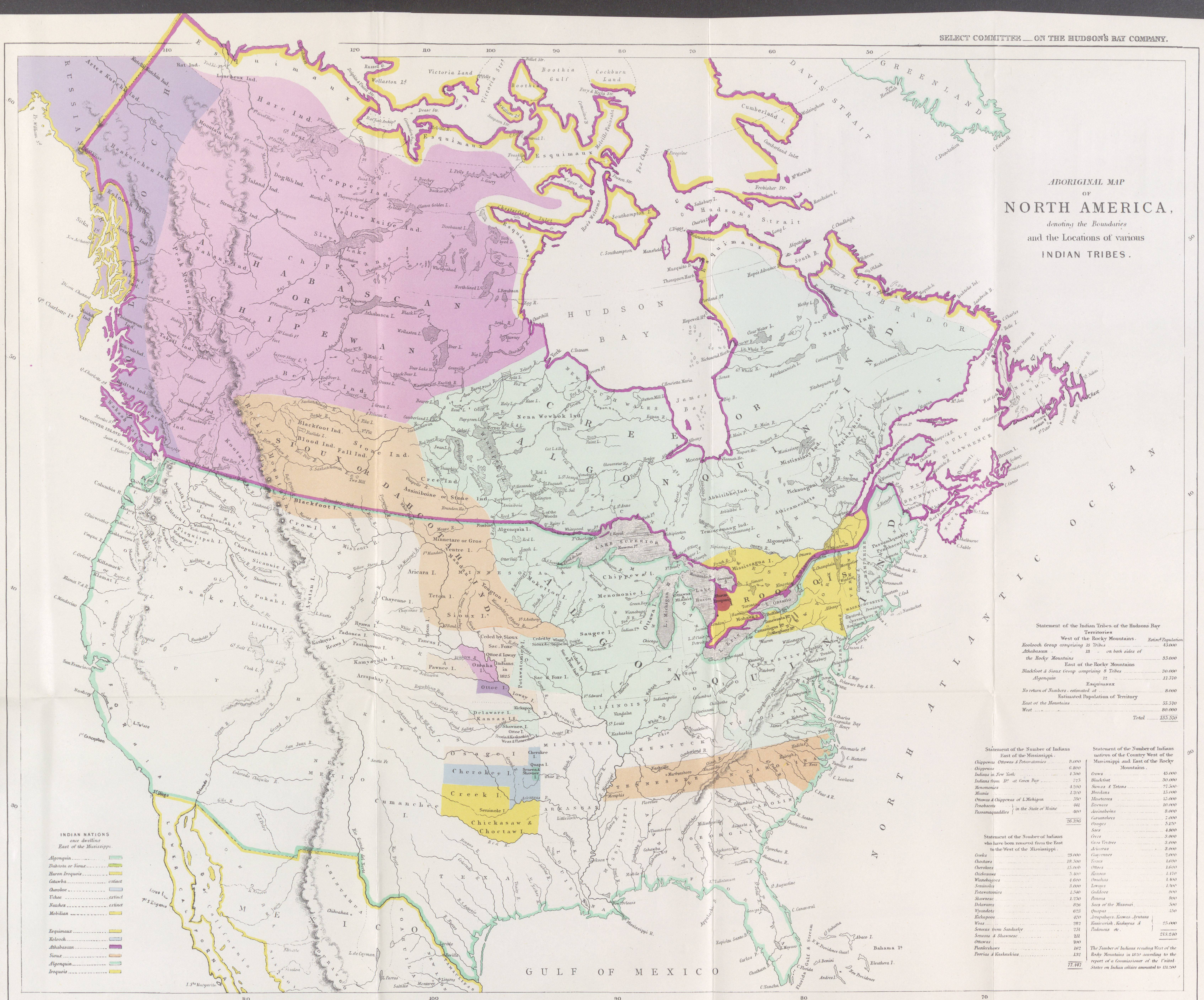


ABORIGINAL MAP
