II. It shall and may be lawful for the said John McLean at any time hereafter to contract matrimony, and to marry with any other woman with whom he might lawfully marry in case the said marriage had not been solemnized.

Issue of future
marriage of John
McLean to be
legitimate.

III. In case of the said John McLean again contracting Matrimony 5
with any person or persons with whom it would have been lawful for him
to contract Matrimony, if they the said John McLean and Diana Hewgill
had not intermarried, and having any issue born to him, the said issue so
born shall be, and are hereby declared to be, to all intents and purposes,
legitimate, and the rights of them the said issue, and of each of them, 10
and of their respective heirs as respects their and each of their capacity
to inherit, have, hold, enjoy, and transmit all, and all manner of property,
real or personal of what nature or kind soever, from any person or persons
whomsoever, shall be and remain the same as they would have been to
all intents and purposes whatsoever, if the marriage between the said 15
John McLean and Diana Hewgill had not taken place.
