Sir :-

Referring to your letter of January 28th, with regard to roads on the Alnwick Indian Reserve, would say,;

The only road on the reserve which the Department has to maintain, and for which we receive the government subsidy, is the road running east, and west, through the reserve, from a point beginning at Location No. 59, on the plan of the reserve, and ending at location No. 35, a distance of about " 2.29 miles, the other cross roads, are taken care of by the Twp of Alnwick, on account of taxes received from white people renting Indian lands.
