Camp Borden	23-4-45		<p>0745 hours, ceiling and visibility unlimited. Flying washed in at 0800 hours and washed out at 1800 hours. Total flying time 258.55 hours. Night flying from 2000 hours to 0500 hours. Flying time 112.55 hours.</p> <p>This morning a Canso aircraft arrived from Rockcliffe for the purpose of spraying DDT solution over the ponds and marshy areas surrounding the camp with a view to destroying Mosquito Larvae. It is hoped that this will in some measure prevent Camp Borden's annual mosquito plague.</p>	
	24-4-45		<p>0745 hours, ceiling 1000' and visibility 1 mile in light rain and haze. No flying all day.</p> <p>Squadron Leader R.W. Philp of No. 1 Air Command made a visit to this unit today to confer with Flying Officer R.L. MacDonald, No. 1 S.F.T.S., Personnel Counsellor, in connection with Personnel Counselling Policy and instructions.</p> <p>R.C.A.F. Camp Borden defeated A.11, Armoured Corps by the score of 11 to 5 in a hard hitting floor hockey game played in the R.C.A.F. Drill Hall at 2000 hours.</p>	
	25-4-45		<p>0745 hours, ceiling and visibility zero in fog. Flying washed in at 1030 hours, local dual only, and washed out at 1200 hours. Total flying time 32.15 hours.</p> <p>The weekly dance was held in the Airmens Mess at 2045 hours with music provided by an Army Band who kindly consented to replace our Station Orchestra which is away from the station on Victory Loan duties.</p> <p>After three days of Victory Loan campaigning a total of 77,650 dollars has been subscribed by 55 per cent of our station personnel.
