Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th Instant, reporting meetings of the Six Nations Council held on the 6th & 7th Instant; and in reply I beg to inform you that the Department approves of the decisions arrived at in the following matters:-

- 1 (page 1) To include in payroll two children, viz Richard and William, of Festus Johnson.
- 2 (pages 3&4) Refusal to accede to the application of Wm. Smoke to be placed on the pension list.
- 3 (Page 4) Appointment of G.A. Martin and Jo as Jonathan as fence viewers for the current year.
- 4 (Pages 6&7) Acceptance of the Tender of Josiah S. Johnson to repair small bridge on side line between lots 16 and 19, Con 4, Tuscorora.
- 5 (page 7) Purchase of a small globe, 1/2 doz common chairs and 8 green curtains for the Thomas' School
- 6 (page 7) Refusal to grant loan applied for by J.S. Johnson.

As regards the resolution of the Chiefs to recognize the Six Nations Brass Band as the Band of the E.D. Cameron Esqr. Council.
