 " therefore clear that no pupil can be
 " credited with an attendance of more
 " than 34 days in the quarter, which is
 " the highest number that can be placed
 " in the "Days present" column. The
 " corrections referred to will alter the
 " total of the Days present column, likewise
 " also the Average attendance during the
 " quarter. The "aggregate attendance during
 " quarter" shown in remarks column will
 " also be affected. The teacher remarks
 " ~~that~~ that the children were away
 " with their parents for 6 weeks, if so this
 " would leave only 24 days remaining in
 " the quarter. The teacher spells the word
 " "Gwayasdums" as here shown. Please ask
 " him to spell it "Quayastums" to agree
 " with the spelling adopted by the Department.
 " I may here remark that your last
 " Quarterly Returns for the quarter ended
 " 31st December 1898 were incorrect in many
 " respects, the columns not added correctly,
 " the "Average for the Quarter" not correct, the
 " "No of Days School was open" and "No of Holiday
 " in quarter" do not agree with the "No of School
 " Days in quarter". I corrected these mistakes for
 " you as as to prevent any further delay in sending
 " in the Returns, but you will see how necessary it
 " is
