manner in which an application for an Order is to be made, the following provisions shall apply: --

- addressed to the judge, in ears of the Clerk of the Court, and shall be in substance a request for an order directing an investigation into the alleged combine, and requesting the judge to fix a time and place for hearing the applicants or their representative to enable them to shew cause why in thepublic interest an investigation should be order.
  - (11) The application shall be accompanied by ---
    - (a) a statement setting forth --
      - (i) The nature of the alleged combine and the persons, companies or corporations believed to be concerned in the same;
      - (ii) The effect of the alleged combine on the price or supply of the article or commodity concerned, or in other ways;
      - (iii) The extent to which the alleged combine
        is believed to operate to the detriment
        of consumers.
      - (iv) The names and addresses of the parties making the application, and the name and address of one of their number, or of a representative, authorized to receive communications and conduct negotiations on their behalf.
