Ottawa 7thMarch, 1918.

I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, in Sirs:regard to the circumstances under which a cheque No 4217 for 50¢, issued by this Department in favour of John Benedict, a St Regis Indian, was paid by the Bank of Montreal, Cornwall at \$50.00; and in reply I regret to say that the amount paid can not , as suggested by you, be collected from the Indian. The only money payable by the Department to Benedict is his interest share, which amounts annually to 50¢ or \$1.00. I may also say that such money can not be retained from him without his consent.
