

Montreal. 22nd March. 1822.

Sir

I have the honor to acknowledge the Receipt of your letter of the 14th ult: conveying to me the sentiments of his Excellency the Governor in Chief, that a Compliance with my request to be admitted to rights of Citizenship under the Existing Laws of the Province could not be granted, and altho' much I regret the circumstance, I should hope that nothing contained in law can exclude me from pursuing my Profession as a Physician. Should I, on examination, be found competent for this purpose I beg leave to inclose a Petition to that Effect to His Excellency supported by Respectable Signatures subjects of His Majesty -
