

NAPIERVILLE

An extensive and flourishing village and parish on the small river Montreal, parish of St. Cyprien, Seigniory of DLy, county of Napierreville, and district of Iberville. It is the *chef lieu* of the county. It possesses considerable water power, several mills and 10 or 12 stores. There is access from Montreal to Stottsville every day. This is universally admitted to be one of the finest grain growing districts in the province. The Circuit Court is held here. Distant from Stottsville, a station of the Montreal, St. Johns and Rouses Point Railway 7 miles, from Sher-rington 9 miles, from L'Acadie 9 miles, from Montreal 27 miles. Mail daily. Population about 1,000.
