## RECORD OF EVENTS.

The great Canadian event of October was the Ontario Provincial Convention held at Toronto on the 3rd and 4th days of the month. The Convention was resolved upon in the early part of the year. When the Plebiscite Act was passed, it was wisely decided that the proposed convention should take place about the time of the commencement of active campaign work, to secure the best possible results from the approaching voting. The convention thus became practically a plebiscite convention, and this fact made it earnest, great and enthusiastic. The Ontario branch of the Dominion Alliance which body had suggested and urged the enactment of the plebiscite measure, decided to take this convention as its annual meeting. The council of the Dominion Alliance announced its annual meeting for the following day. There was a mighty rally of earnest prohibitionists realizing the vast importance of the crisis that had brought them together. Canadian workers already have a full knowledge of the work done by the Convention. With the object of having a convenient record of it, a condensed report will be published in the December VAN-

The other principle events of October were the Annual Convention of the World's Woman's Christian Temperance Union at Chicago, on October 16th, the Annual Convention of the American National Woman's Christian Temperance Union at Chicago on October 18th, and the Annual Meeting of the United Kingdom Alliance at Manchester, England, on October 24th.
