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The Scholastic year is divided into four Terms of ten weeks each. Michaelmas Term begins on Wednesday, 5th September.

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FRENCH is the language spoken in the College, and a French Service is held in the Chapel every Sunday afternoon.

The College is under the personal supervision of the Bishop, with a large staff of English and Foreign Professors. The Musical Department is under the management of Miss CLINTON, who holds certificates from SIR STERNDAL BENNET and CHAPMAN POTTER.
