When Napoleon and the Emperor of Russia met at Erfurt, near Weimar, in 1808, the former patronized Goethe by summoning him to a private audience...

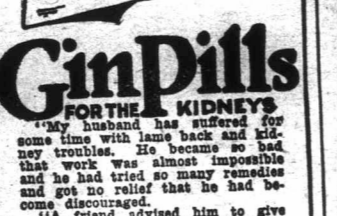
"Karl August came into his study accompanied by the King of Bavaria, who brought with him the Order of the Grand Cross as a homage."
