ALL PROVINCES TOASTED

Glories of the Dominion Described by Citizens From Every Section—American Guests and Their President Cheered—Patriotic Addresses.

The inclement weather of Thursday prevented an outdoor demonstration of the enthusiasm which was pent up in the heart of every Canadian in Rossland.

The day did not pass off, however, without a very pleasant and creditable demonstration in the shape of an impromptu banquet which took place in the Grand Union hotel last night.

After disposing of the available and plentiful edibles that burdened the table, Chairman Hewitt opened the speaking and toast-making by outlining the object of the gathering—to observe the thirtieth anniversary of the confederation of the Canadian provinces.

The banqueters joined heartily in the toast and sang "He's a Jolly Good Fellow," adding three rousing cheers for the president.

Chairman Hewitt announced a toast for every province in the Dominion, from the Atlantic to the Pacific ocean.

The toast to the Army and Navy was responded to by Major Cooper and Messrs. Harp and Campbell.

Mayor Scott was called upon to speak for the city of Rossland.

SETTLED OUT OF COURT

Dispute Between Good Friday and Indiana Con. Disposed Of.

New Company Organized to Take Over Both Claims and Two Adjoining Fractions—Splendid Showings.
