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2,000 DOURKHOBORS

Landed in St. John, N.B., and Then Embarked on the Train for the West.

St. John, N.B., Jan. 24.—The steamer Huron, with the Dourkhobors on board, arrived here yesterday at 4 p.m., and, although it was dead low water, the steamer came right up to the wharf. The C.P.R. train cars for five trains, with locomotives, coaches, were at Sand Point ready to receive the Dourkhobors, who were placed on the train in the rear of the warehouse. The police cars contained several hundred men, plenty of fresh water, etc., and were very comfortable, while the tourist cars, besides having a few seats, were also provided with a neat and cosy sleeping compartment, where the Dourkhobors, after a night's rest, were ready to leave for the west.

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
