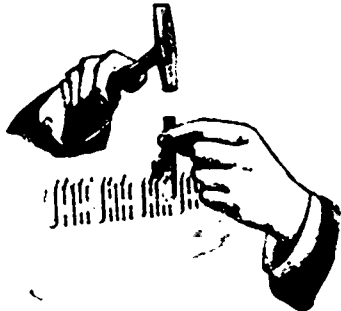

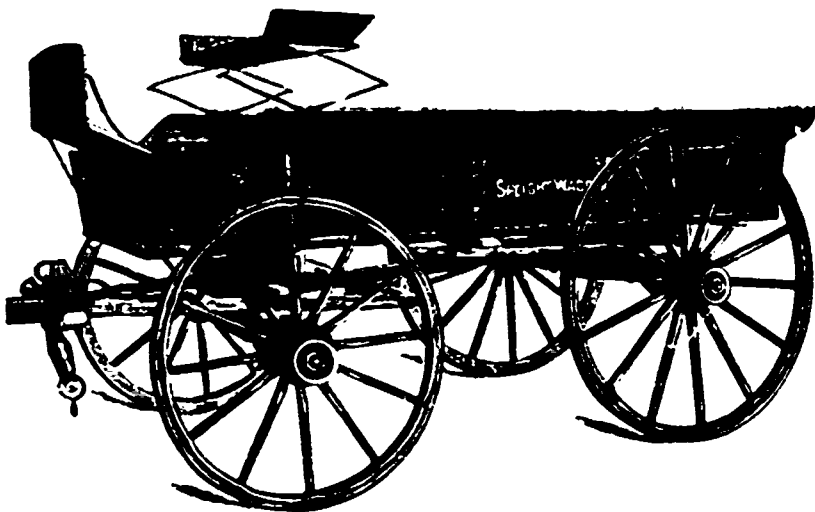
..Maple Leaf Saw Set..



**Directions:** Lay the Set on the point of tooth as shown in the above cut, and strike a very light blow with a 1 1/2 lb hammer. If you require more set, lay the tooth with more bevel. If you follow directions you cannot make a mistake. Be sure and not strike too hard a blow, and it will set the hardest saw.

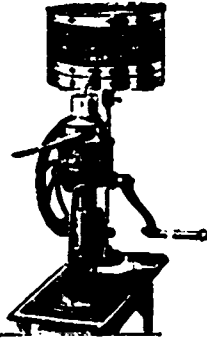

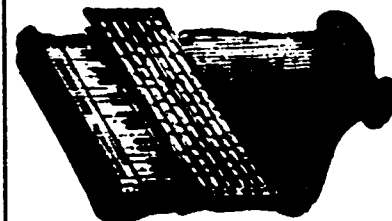
