ribs, and will be for a few centuries to come, notwithstayding the very strong anti-British and B. C. spirit which our i American amicusses are showing.

The press of the United States became instantly aflame with the news of t "wealth beyond the dreams of avarice" on the Clondyke. It couldn't awake itself, but all newspaper readers between the Atlantic and Pacific awoke one morning to find the place famous and fabulous. The latter word is used advisedly. No doubt many wondered where the place was and are still wondering. The newspaper outbreak was so spontaneous and unlooked for, that there arises a very strong suspicion that the whole matter was organized and is the result of Uncle Sam's smartness to divert and draw away attention from the mining prospects of British Columbia.

Apropos the "Clondyka Fever," the Western Mining World has this to say: "While it is fair to assume that Alaska has much mineral wealth, and that several really promising placers have been discovered, it is folly to believe that the Associated Press reports concerning the phenomenal wealth of the country are based on facts. reports are brought in largely in the interests of speculators and are given credence by many because large amounts of gold, the accumulations of years of hard work in the interior of the country, have recently been shipped to the states. Prudence suggests a conservative view of the situation, and those who seriously contemplate casting their lot in Alaska should bear in mind that in a few weeks at the outs. ; mining in that far northern region will close down until the advent of another summer. Prospecting will be impossible in the fall and winter months and a dreary and expensive wait is before the man who thoughtlessly rushes off to Alaska at this season of the year. No one should think of leaving for that country before next spring, and by that time perhaps the core will have been carved out of the boom and the true inwardness of the situation made plain."

AGASSIZ, July 28.-Quietly a considerable amount of staking off has been going on for some time. (Where?) That is the question!
