HOT ROLLS .- Into one pound of flour put two ounces of butter ; add the whites of three eggs well beaten and half a pint of hop yeast with a little salt and milk enough to make a stiff dough. Set in a warm place until light; work; make in long rolls; glaze, with melted butter and bake in a quick oven.

PREPARED MUSHROOMS .- Put in a sauce pan a little stock parsley and half a pound of butter; melt, and lay in sliced mushrooms; remove from the fire and let stand for an hour; at the end of that time set on the fire to brown. Sprinkle in a tablespoonful of flour, mix smooth, and pour in a cup of boiling water; add a glass of Madeira wine and the juice of a lemon; season with salt and pepper


MUSHROOM PATES .--- Cut up one quart of mushrooms with one teaspoon of salt, pepper, mace and the juice of a lemon. Put in a saucepan, simmer twenty minutes. Have six sweetbreads parboiled and cut in small pieces ; dredge with grated cracker and put in a sauce pan; add a glass of wine and a tablespoon of currant jelly, with a bunch of chopped parsley; let boil five minutes. Have baked in small patty pans nice puff paste, in which drop a spoonful of the mixture. Serve hot.

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


