precate any action that does not regard primitive and established principles of jurisdiotion, and the interests of the whole Anglican communion (Resolutions $a, b, c, d, e$, were carried nemine contradicente).
16. That, baving regard to the fact that the queation of the relation of the Anglican Church to the Unitas Fratrum, or Moraviana, wes re mitted by the last Lambeth Conference to a committee, which bas bitherto presented no report on the subject, the Archbishop of Canterbury be requested to appoint a oommittee of Bisbope who shall be empowered to confer with learned theologians, and with the heads of the Unitas Fratrum, and shall report to his Grace bofore the ond of the carrent year, and that his Grace be requosted to take such aotion on their report as he shall deem right.
17. That this Conference, rejoioing in the friendly communications which have passed betweon the Archbishops of Canterbary and othor Anglican Bishops, and the Patriarchs of Constantinople and other Eastern Patriarohs and Bishops, desires to express its hope that the barriers to fuller communion may be, in course of time, removed by farther intercoarse and extondad enlightenment. The Conference commends this subject to the devont prayers of the faithful, and rocommends that the connsels and efforts of our fellow Chriatians should be directed to the encouragement of interal reformation in the Eastorn Churohes rather than to the drawing away from them of individual members of their communion.
18. That the Archbishop of Canterbary be requested to tako counsel with such persons as ho may ree fit to consult, with a view to ascertaining whether it is desirable to revise the English version of the Nicene Creed or of the Quicunque vult. (Carried by 57 votes to 20 )
19. That, as regards newly constituted Churchos, especially in non Christian lands, it sbould bo a condition of the recognition of thom as in complete inter commanion with us, and especially of their receiving from us Episcopal succession, that we should first receive from them satisfactory evidence that they hold subetantially the same doctrine as our own, and that their Clorgy sabsoribe Articles in accordanco with the express statements of onr own standurds of doctrine and worship; bat that they should not necessarily bo bound to aocept in their entirety tho Thirty-nine Articles of Roligion.

## TIA LAMBETH CONFERENCE.

The deliberations of tho Conference closed on Friday, 27 h July, and the results of the venerable Assemlity's diseussions will be pablished in a fow days by the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledgo. On Saturday, 28th Jaly, at St. Paul's there was a valedictory function of unexampled dignity and impressiveness. The Cathedral wat opened to the publio at ten, and in a fow minutus the area under the dome was complotely filled, the vast concourse gradually increasing till it reached nearly to the space near the west door, which had boen railed off for convenionco in marshalling the procession. Thesouth aiele of the nave had also been sot aphet as at robing-room ; and as oleven o'clock appronchod the Prelates and others were, through the exertions of the Dean of Windsor: arranged in the following order:
