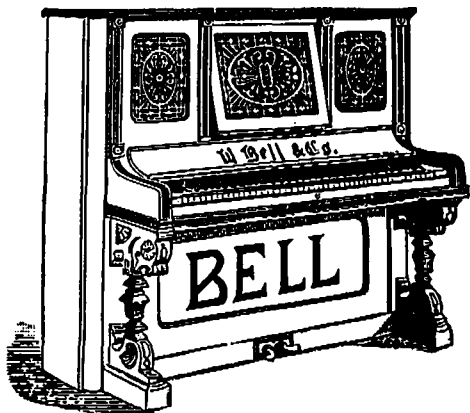

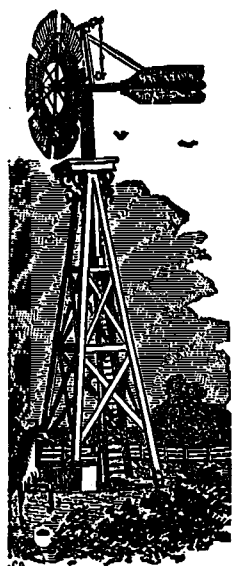
BOYS FOR FARM HELP.
