Hebrew and Arabic are the official languages; English is widely spoken.

In Israel, supreme authority rests with the Knesset, a unicameral legislative body with 120 members elected for a fouryear term. Knesset consent is required for the installation of a new Cabinet, which must resign on losing confidence. The President is elected by the Knesset.
