Resolution II

## FINANCIAL AND ALLOCATION ARRANGEMENTS

The United Nations Technical Assistance Conference,

Approves the following financial arrangements recommended in paragraph 9 of resolution 222 A (IX) of the Economic and Social Council:

- (a) Contributions shall be made by Governments in such forms and subject to such conditions as may be agreed between the Secretary-General, after consultation with the Technical Assistance Board established pursuant to resolution 222 A (IX) of the Economic and Social Council, and the participating Governments, provided that contributions shall be made without limitation as to use by a specific agency, or in a specific country or for a specific project.
- (b) The Secretary-General shall allot contributions received during the first fiscal year as follows:
- (i) The first \$10,000,000 in contributions shall automatically be available for distribution to the participating organizations for the expanded technical assistance programme;
