The Canadian Delegation to the Fourth Session of the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, to be held at Paris from September 19 to October 15, will be headed by Mr. John B. C. Watkins, Charge d'Affaires, Canadian Embassy, Moscow, it was announced today by Mr. L. B. Pearson, Secretary of State for External Affairs.
