In fact, even the name Emmenin could be used there, unless McGill University determined to defend it at law. In other words, at the present time, it would be practically as easy to introduce the substance under one name as another. We, on the other hand, are definitely convinced of the advisability of using the name Emmenin in Great Britain, as well as in Canada and the United States, and toward this end, suggest that either McGill University register the name in Great Britain, or acquiesce in this procedure being followed by ourselves, we, in turn, permitting Glaxo Laboratories to use it there. This alternative is suggested in view of recognized difficulties, which, it has been stated, would confront the University in undertaking registration themselves in Great Britain. In this connection, we suggest for your consideration the thought that in Canada and the United States some plan might be evolved whereby the name Emmenin could be transferred to ourselves and, thus, dissociate McGill University from any tangible connection with its commercial side. Mr. H. Jephcott, Managing Director of Glaxo Laboratories, will be leaving from New York toward the end of the present week, in view of which we would appreciate a reply, if possible, early enough to permit us to contact with Mr. Jephcott before he sails, should any further discussion be necessary.
