An Act respecting the Hours of Labour on Public Works.

H IS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—Definition.

 5 "extraordinary emergency" means an emergency that can-Extraordinate not be foreseen, such as might be necessary for saving life or ary property and not causes which depend for their emergency solely upon economical methods of work or importance of rapid construction.
- 2. This Act shall not apply—

 (a) to purchases made in the open market by the Government of Canada;

 Exceptions to application of Act.

(b) to work upon public, military or naval works or defences in time of war;

- 15 (c) to purchases made in the open market by the contractor, sub-contractor or other persons referred to in section 6 of this Act;
 - (d) to contracts for the transmission of intelligence;(e) to contracts for transportation by land or water;

20 (f) to agricultural work.

- 3. This Act shall apply to work undertaken by the Gov-Day labour.
- 4. Without restricting the application of this Act, it is Application declared that it includes—
- 25 (a) contracts for the erection, remodelling, construction Public works. or repair of all public works, such as post offices, custom houses, armouries, Intercolonial stations, freight sheds or locomotive equipment, wharves, piers, breakwaters, railroads, canals, dredges, navy yards, arsenals,
