We would remind you that the success of the Epworth League will depend very largely upon the degree of hearty co-operation and affectionate interest which it receives from the older members of the Church, and would suggest that all, but especially Pastors and Ollicial members of our churches, should familiarize themselves with the constitution and aims of this thoroughly Methodistic institution in order that they may be prepared to wisely direct its operations. There can be no question that the sainted founder of Methodism would have been quick to avail himself of this effective means of influencing young Christians, and training them for usefulness in the future.

We are convinced that there is hardly a Church throughout the Conference where it would be impracticable to form a League, as the department of Christian Endeavor, which is the very heart and soul of the movement, can be worked successfully, where the number of members is very small; and would recommend that wherever half a dozen young people can be gathered together, they should be organized into a League to work for God and the salvation of souls. Difficulties will have to be met and obstacles overcome, but we are convinced the results will amply repay the affort expended.
