

Works, Public—continued.

2. *Canada:*

Carrying on in Canada obliges officers of the commissariat being frequently employed as clerks, and thereby increases the expense of that department, *Green* 1150—Opinion that the completion of the public works in Canada would not lessen the number of regular troops in that colony, as a force would be requisite for their protection, *Kempt* 636-639.

3. *New Brunswick:*

Extent of the public works for strengthening the province of New Brunswick, *Hay* 197.

4. *New South Wales:*

Extent the commissariat of New South Wales is connected with the public buildings in that colony, *Archer* 863-865—An engineer officer has latterly been sent to New South Wales to take charge of the public works, *Archer* 256.
