

Bible

Arrange Bible according to the grouping of the Books of the Bible, not alphabetically. Within these groups arrange: 1. Complete texts. 2. Selections. 3. Special phases of the Bible, as Antiquities, Commentaries, etc.

Example.

Bible—Antiquities.

Bible. Old Testament—Selections.
Bible. Old Testament—Criticism.
Bible. Old Testament. Genesis.
Bible. Old Testament. Genesis. Indian.

Bible. New Testament. Gospels.
Bible. New Testament. Colossians.

Bishop's *see* and Nobleman's title

Arrange a bishop's *see* and a nobleman's title among the personal names, not among the places.

Example.

Salisbury, Edward, bp. of.
Salisbury, Edward Elbridge.
Salisbury, Robert Cecil, 1st earl of.
Salisbury.
Salisbury—Cathedral.

Compiler, *see* Author arrangement.

Compound forenames, *see* Forenames, Compound.

Compound names of places, *see* Places, Compound names.

Compound surnames, *see* Surnames, Compound.

Congresses

Arrange congresses or conferences distinguished by number or date chronologically, not alphabetically.

Example.

International geographic congress, 6th, London, 1895.
International geographic congress, 9th, Geneva, 1908.

Dates, *see* Numerals.

Editor, *see* Author arrangement.

Elisions, *see* Abbreviations.

Family names, *see* Surnames. Family names.
