He is the designer, the great first cause of all that enters into the physical, mental and moral conditions of our nature. In Him we live and move and have our being. The knowledge of God, as the God of our fathers and mothers is an intuition. We believe in His existence because we cannot help doing so. It is an axiom, a self-evident truth.
