ESPLANADE VIADUCT PLANS.

It is said that but few changes have been made in the plans for the proposed railway viaduct, which are now before the railway board at Ottawa.

The viaduct, it is said, will run across the city from Strachan-avenue to Logan-avenue, crossing the Don River over the present bridge, which will be raised.

There will be no level crossings between Logan and Strachan after the viaduct is up. The present John-street bridge will be raised. It is said, and the Spadina-avenue bridge will be extended over the level crossing which is now at the end.

For taking cars from the elevated tracks to warehouses and for the wharves spur lines will, it is said, run down the sides of the viaduct to the ground level.
