From the Rev. H. STAMER, Hubbard's Cove.

"As the time has fully arrived for handing in the lists of the Diocesan Church Society, I hasten to forward that for the Mission of Hubbard's Cove, amounting to \$40.00, which comes short of last year's by a few dollars; and although such is the case, I am not disheartened, as the following causes will satisfactorily account for the deficiency. At the present moment, I am using every exertion in my power to collect Subscriptions for rebuilding their Church, amounting to \$520.00, add to which another subscription list, amounting to \$200.00, which Mr. Silver left to be collected. With this amount of work before me, I must confess, I felt timid, when I commenced soliciting the usual Contributions for the Diocesan Church Society, and would willingly transfer the task to other hands, if such could be found. However, I had to go through with it, and I was not sorry when it was ended, as I know of no occupation more unpleasant than that of asking for money."

I beg to enclose you the Subscription list from this Parish, to the D. C. S., for the year 1869.

The whole amount sent up to this day, \$102.29 has been obtained through the Offertory, with the exception of about \$12.00, which had to be collected after the former method, owing to its being impossible from the scattered condition of the contributors to bring the Offertory to bear upon them.

I am truly thankful to find that we have made a considerably larger offering than on any previous year. The parties who have not yet paid in, fully purpose to do so. I hope to be able to obtain their amounts before your memorandum of receipts goes to press.
