and Nine for the election of Office-Bearers. All questions shall be decided by a majority of the respective quorums. The Chairman shall have a deliberative vote, and, in case of an equal division, a casting vote.

- 3. Gentlemen desirous of becoming Members shall be proposed and seconded a week previous to their being admitted.
- 4. The Society shall meet in the Religious Institution Rooms every Tuesday Evening, at Eight o'Clock, for Five Months, commencing the First Tuesday of November.
- 5. No Member shall be allowed to speak twice on the same subject, until the other Members have had an opportunity of expressing their opinions.
- 6. The Essay or Debate shall follow the approval of the minutes, and take precedence of all other business.
- 7. The Constitution and Bye-Laws shall be subscribed by all Members of the Society.
