and Nine for the election of Office-Bearers. All questions shall be decided by a majority of the respective quorums. The Chairman shall have a deliberative vote, and, in case of an equal division, a casting vote.

3. Gentlemen desirous of becoming Members shall be proposed and seconded a week previous to their being admitted.

4. The Society shall meet in the Religious Institution Rooms every *Tuesday Evening*, at *Eight o'Clock*, for Five Months, commencing the First Tuesday of November.

5. No Member shall be allowed to speak twice on the same subject, until the other Members have had an opportunity of expressing their opinions.

6. The Essay or Debate shall follow the approval of the minutes, and take precedence of all other business.

7. The Constitution and Bye-Laws shall be subscribed by all Members of the Society.
