RADIO FAN LOSES THUMB FILING DOWN A CARTRIDGE

New York, June 12.—Thomas Flanagan, thirty-seven years old of the Bronx, started tinkering with a radio outfit as soon as he returned home from business. He attempted to construct a little copper tube from the casing of a 22 calibre cartridge, trying to file it to the shape he desired. The cartridge exploded in his hand and tore off his left thumb, badly lacerating four fingers. Bleeding profusely from a severed artery, the injured man directed the members of the family to make a tourniquet. This he bound around the stub of his injured thumb. Dr. Hunter took him to Lincoln Hospital, where the thumb was amputated.
