Deputy Sheriff Meers of Woodstock has been advised that his son, Lieutenant Robert Meers, is reported missing since August 16. Three sons of Mr. and Mrs. Meers enlisted in the army—Douglas, in France; Ray, in invalid home, and Robert. Mrs. A. F. Winslow of Woodstock was notified yesterday that her son, Randolph Winslow, had been wounded in the head. He crossed overseas with the first contingent. James Robert Tomlinson, of Tay Settlement, has been notified that his son, Private Gordon T. Tomlinson, has died of wounds. Bedford Long of Millford has received word that his son, Corporal Robert Long, has been slightly wounded and has been admitted to a military hospital in France. Mr. and Mrs. John Curtis, of East Bridgewater, Mass., formerly of Woodstock, N. B., have been notified that their son, Pte. William A. Curtis, has been officially reported missing since Aug. 10. According to a report from Ottawa, Canada's expeditionary force to Siberia will in all probability be mobilized in Vancouver or Victoria. Mrs. Ira D. Farris, 254 Britain street, received a cable yesterday from her brother-in-law, Gunner F. W. Farris, announcing his safe arrival in England. Mr. and Mrs. Charles Scott of Sackville, have been advised that their son, Private Fred Scott, has been killed in action. He crossed overseas as a member of the 146th Battalion. The names of six New Brunswick men appeared in the midnight casualty list: Wounded, J. H. Dougherty, Forest Glen; R. R. Hallett, Millville; J. R. Parker, Campbellton; E. Polier, Balmoral; W. D. Andrews, Fort Midway. Died of wounds—F. Armstrong, Perth. A party of soldiers from the Military Hospital in St. James street were entertained to a dinner and a drive to the summer home of David Watson at Glen Cottage.
