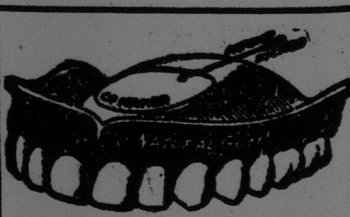

**NEW TYPE OF ROBBERS**  
STEAL ONLY STATUARY  
Austrian Shrines and Chisels Being Plundered of Priceless Relics.

Vienna, Nov. 10. (By mail).—A series of robberies of wayside shrines, private chapels, cross-roads monuments and other medieval statuary is occurring all over Austria. The thefts are so skillfully planned that only carvings and statues of high artistic or historic value are taken, leading the police to believe that they are directed by experts.

Austria is rich in these relics. In remote and lonely places all over the country are rare and wonderful monuments, often dating from the Middle Ages, and some even said to be of Roman origin. In the Tyrol and Styria particularly, on high passes or on the sites of ancient churches, are to be found relics, carvings, statuary or tablets almost priceless to the anti-

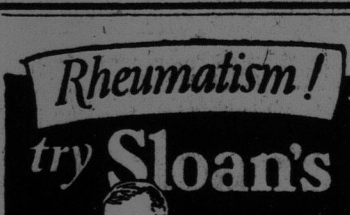

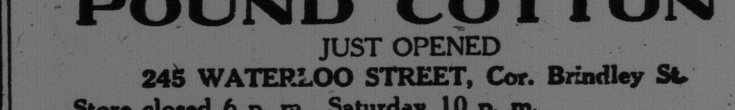
