It is like risking a renewal of the Anglo-Saxon schism for the sake of the Venezuelan claims, or like provoking a war with France in order to secure certain swamps at Fashoda. But it is best that swamps of irritation should be removed, and although it is discreditable alike to English and American statesmen that the Alaska dispute should have been allowed to drag on for such an unconscionable period, we hope that we may now hear of its decent burial." Could there be a finer example of the spirit of "conciliation" which has cost Canada territory amounting almost to the proportions of an empire on this continent? were to give up the fight and precipitate a general election. That would be the easiest way out of an evidently hopeless situation. It would hasten the consummation of the new political formation which must precede a stable administration. Great Britain is evidently on the eve of one of the greatest political revolutions since the days preceding the repeal of the corn laws. The world has moved since the agitation in 1842 and thereabouts when the cry of the followers of Sir Robert Peel was that we must have cheap bread or the people will starve. The agricultural area of the world has greatly broadened. But it is scarcely to be expected that the triumphs of the principles advocated by Mr. Chamberlain will be immediate. Events are forcing Mr. Balfour over to the side of his late Colonial Secretary, but there will evidently be a long campaign of education carried on before the bulk of the electorate fall in behind them. It is just as well at this time to frankly state the facts. Canada has led the way to a closer union by the adoption of a preferential trade policy. That movement has been fought virulently by the old Tory party of Canada. That party has not given up the fight yet by any means. It is not bold enough to wage open warfare, but at stated intervals the cry is raised that Canadian interests are being ruined. Corresponding elements in other colonies are pursuing like tactics. But if Great Britain should ever reach the point at which her people are prepared to consider a policy designed to knit the Empire in firmer relations the opposition in Canada, or, we believe, in any other colony, will soon be swept away. In the meantime the British are not disposed to take a step they believe in their timorous souls will provoke foreign retaliation and increase the cost at home of the necessities of life. There is no immediate prospect of preferential trade being adopted, and each unit of the Empire must pursue the course it deems best in its own interests. Canada has made the first move. She can afford to give others time to consider the situation and make up their minds.

The colonies of the British Empire are too firmly rooted in their loyalty for public opinion to be seriously affected by the arguments that may be advanced in the course of the political campaign now in full flame in the Mother Country. We are getting accustomed to that sort of thing. But there is a limit, and if it be demonstrated that the public men who, or the public press which, at all times ostentatiously espouse the cause of foreigners when they come in conflict with despised colonies, reflect the sentiments of the people of Great Britain, then there will soon arise an element in Canada who will want to know whether the time for a change is not drawing near. We suppose it would be asking too much of a certain section of the British press to request it to inform itself upon Canadian questions before presuming to comment upon them. To that element the fact that there is a matter in dispute between Canada and the United States is sufficient reason for pooh-poohing our pretensions and asking if it be worth while by doing abstract justice to run the risk of offending the great friend and ally of England. Let our readers ponder over the following and ask themselves what the future relations of the colonies with the Empire are likely to be if a party animated by the sentiments of the Daily News should be returned to and maintained in power for any considerable time: "It is, therefore, manifestly absurd that such a result should be imperilled by the kind of inflammatory language used by the Attorney-General in his opening of the British case, who complained that the United States, desiring to cut Canada off from the ocean, wished to draw a frontier line which was an ostentatious defiance of the terms of the 1825 treaty. Here is a distinct charge of malice fides against a friendly and nearly related power. There must be differences of view in the interpretation of a treaty which, like that determining the Chili-Argentine frontier, attempted to lay down a scientific frontier, partly by means of a leveling line, the successive peaks of a mountain range. But it is preposterous that, in discussing so complicated a question, the senior legal adviser to His Majesty's government should make use of expressions which, even if justified by actual facts, would be much better left unsaid. On the facts, however, we are not by any means certain that the British case is a possession, which, after all, is nine points of the law, but many quite impartial authorities consider that their case on the treaty is unanswerable. This may or may not prove to be the ruling of the commission. In any case we hope that the arguments will be couched in phrases which do not impute bad motives."

THE EXHIBITION IS NOW IN FULL SWING Annual Show Far Ahead of Any Previous Year --Exhibits Are of a High Order-- Numerous Attractions.

Beautiful weather marked the opening of the provincial annual show, which took place this morning. After some forty-eight hours of rain and wind the storm which prevailed Sunday and Monday exhausted itself last night and this morning the sun shone through a cloudless sky. The exhibition building presented an animated appearance from early morning. Flags flew from every pinnacle, and there was some army of industrious exhibitors and their helpers busy putting the finishing touches to their display. It was the same on the grounds. Managers of the various side shows were engaged in superintending the establishment of marquees and ladies of the different local societies were present to attend to the erection of rest tents in convenient spots. Perhaps, however, the busiest place of all was the secretary's office. Throughout the forenoon the office was crowded, and R. H. Swinerton and staff had their hands full to attend to the numerous and varied matters submitted to them. At 2.30 o'clock this afternoon the formal opening of the fair took place. His Honor Sir Henri Joly de Lotbiniere officiating. There was a large crowd in attendance, auguring well for the success of the show. After the Lieutenant-Governor had said the words which declared Victoria's exhibition of 1903 open those present dispersed either to the athletic grounds for the purpose of witnessing the football match between the Garrison and Columbia teams, or to the exhibition building to inspect the interior exhibits, or to the exhibition grounds to see the stock exhibit. This morning about 10.30 the first event of the week's programme of sports commenced and is being continued all day. Through the efforts of members of the local gym club about sixteen entries in all were received for the trap shooting and competition for the "Four O'Clock" challenge is therefore close. Four of Vancouver's crack shots arrived last night to take part, among whom are J. C. MacIure, formerly of this city, and Mr. Hillis. There are also four shots from Seattle. Altogether eight local shots are competing, among whom is Otto Weiler, who last year captured the trophy. Commencing at 3 o'clock the first of the series of championship matches between the Victoria, Garrison and Columbia teams is taking place. The game today is between the Columbia and Garrison teams, the winners to play off with Victoria to-morrow for prize medals presented by the British Columbia Agricultural Association. Following is the Columbia team: Goal, W. Kinsman; full-backs, J. Johnson and Aikens; half-backs, Alex. Johnson, K. Hughes and A. Butcherford; forwards, C. Berkley, J. Finlayson, W. Wilson, Moore and J. Lawson. The Fifth Regiment band was in attendance and gave a programme of musical selections during the formal opening ceremonies and is in attendance this afternoon during the progress of the football match. Grains of different varieties, more particularly wheat, figure prominently in the display. Roots of enormous sizes are shown. A magnificent assortment of preserved fruits add to the effect of the exhibit. Together, almost everything raised by the farmers of the district is well represented. The best displayed in the arrangement is highly commendable and J. L. Chapman, who has charge of the exhibit, is to be congratulated on the result of his efforts. The display from Okanagan district was not complete this morning, but if indications are to be depended on it will prove a strong competitor for first place. S. French, who is in charge, this morning informed a representative of the Times that the exhibit would be particularly strong in fruit, roots and grain. Although the season, he said, had not been quite warm enough for the successful growth of fruit, there had been in a great many cases some first-class fruit raised. J. N. and Miss Martindale were this morning busy putting the finishing touches on the Victoria district exhibit. Fruit are especially largely represented in this display, and judging by their appearance the orchards of Saanich have been yielding excellent specimens this season. Grain and other farm produce are included in the display, but arranged in a manner that sets off the strong points to advantage. Occupying a prominent place in the display is an Indian idol, which was ploughed up on Wm. Thomson's farm. Nevertheless, the attendance was very fair in view of the threatening attitude of the weather which had lighted before, and this will easily be doubled and trebled as the event progresses. When His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor pronounced the words which threw open the doors to the public, the meteorological conditions were as favorable as the most exacting could desire. The day was bright, the sun shone brightly through an unobscured sky and joyfully presaged an ideal brand of weather throughout the entire week. Sir Henri, Mrs. Oliver and party arrived at the scene of the exhibition at 10 o'clock and were received by His Worship Mayor M. C. McCandless and Secretary R. H. Swinerton amid the strains of the National Anthem played by the band. They were escorted to the striking entrance in the main building, where His Honor was to speak the words that started the machinery in motion. Mayor McCandless expressed deep regret at the splendid character of the exhibition, which, in his opinion, surpassed those of the past two years. These, unfortunately, had not been financially successful, but with favorable weather and hearty support of the public he had every reason to believe the association would make this one pay its way. Briefly alluding to the exhibits, His Worship commented on their very satisfactory character. He regretted that owing to circumstances beyond the control of the association Salt Spring was not represented this year. He specially referred to the mineral exhibit of the department, which he hoped His Honor would see, as it was of the most interesting character. In formally opening the exhibition Sir Henri Joly said: "Mr. Mayor, officials, ladies and gentlemen—I do not intend to detain you long, because I am anxious to see the exhibits, and I know you are. Last year I viewed with much interest the exhibition and derived therefrom very much pleasure. I am anxious to see that this year's exhibition is better than that of last year. The weather of Monday was against your success, but we trust that it will only urge you to give the committee your heartiest support in every way. The exhibition is not held only for exhibitors; producers and manufacturers, but so that the general public may get a correct impression of our progress in industrial and agricultural pursuits and everything that tends to the betterment and prosperity of the whole province. I now declare this exhibition open and wish you, Mr. Mayor, and managers of the association every success in your undertaking, and I trust that everyone in the district will feel it his and her duty to attend and thus ensure the success of this exhibition of 1903."
