

may be,) reckoning from the building or wall to be built or repaired; and such materials shall not extend lengthways in front, beyond that of the lot whereon the building or wall is to be erected or repaired, and from time to time, as the materials are worked up, or such building or repairs finished, the undertaker of such building or repairs, or the proprietor or occupier of the wall or buildings so erected or repaired, shall cause the whole space which the said materials occupied to be cleared, and the said timber, rail, rubbish and remaining materials and scaffolds to be carried away. Any undertaker, proprietor, or occupier aforesaid, in any way offending against this Regulation, shall forfeit and pay twenty shillings; and if any such person shall refuse or neglect to carry away or cause to be carried away, within the time aforesaid, the said timber rail, rubbish, scaffolds and materials finally remaining, after the outside of the building so built or repaired shall have been finished, it shall be lawful for the Surveyor of the Roads to cause the same to be removed and carried away at the expence of such offender.

ART. 5. No person shall square, saw or frame any timber on the beach or in any square, street or lane within the City or Suburbs; but all timber works, after they shall have been wholly framed, shall be brought to the place for which
