

and also to do, perform, and execute all other matters and things requisite and necessary, useful or convenient, for erecting and building, maintaining and supporting the said intended Bridge, Toll-house, Turnpike 5 and other dependencies, according to the tenor and true meaning of this Act.

A. M. Delisle and others authorized to use the land on either side of the River Jésus, and work up materials necessary for constructing the bridge, making a reasonable satisfaction to the respective owners and occupiers of the lands for the damages done to the same.

II. And be it enacted, That for the purpose of erecting, building, maintaining and supporting the said Bridge, the said Alexander Maurice Delisle, Benjamin Henri Lemoine, and Jean Baptiste Debien, their heirs, executors, curators and assigns, shall from time to time, have full power and authority to take and use the land on either side 15 of the said river, and there to work up or cause to be worked up the materials and other things necessary for erecting, constructing or repairing the said Bridge accordingly, and also to take possession for their 20 use and as their property of certain pieces of ground on each side of the said River Jésus at the place where they shall erect and build the said Bridge, to establish, make and open a road to communicate between the 25 said Bridge and the public road or Queen's highway, the said Alexander Maurice Delisle, Benjamin Henri Lemoine and Jean Baptiste Debien, their heirs, executors, curators and assigns, and the persons by them 30 employed, doing as little damage as may be, and making reasonable and just satisfaction to the respective owners and occupiers of all such lands and grounds as shall be altered, damaged or made use of, for the value of 35 such land as well as for that of the alteration or of the damages which they may cause to the proprietors, by means of or for the purpose of erecting the said Bridge and the said Toll-house, and the opening of the said 40 road or roads, as above designated; and in case of difference of opinion and dispute about the *quantum* of such satisfaction, the same shall be settled by Her Majesty's Court of Queen's Bench for the District of Mon- 45
