AN ESCORT WHOSE DUTY IT WAS TO HAVE  
HIM IN CHARGE"

in the Field, at approximately 2100 hours on the 6th Jul 44 resisted arrest and put up a fight at the "Feathers' Inn", Laleham, Middlesex.
